Well, that's the SECOND mistake. The update is (and I promise, this IS the one ;) : Microsoft Security Bulletin MS06-057  
Vulnerability in Windows Explorer Could Allow Remote Execution (923191)

There are active exploits circulating on the internet and the above should be installed ASAP.

I don't *\*think\** that any of the updates are causing the issue. Then again, I could be wrong ;)

I don't use the web-based reader, rather through an email client, so I

don't see popups here.

Suggest you install the updates one at a time and then test if functionality is hindered on your web page.

Since the thumbnails are dependent on javascript to open I'd look to the blocking of javascript on your system as being the culprit.

None of the updates deal with javascript.

BTW, I posted the \*wrong\* update that should be installed ASAP. It's this one: Microsoft Security Bulletin MS06-055

I did not see the yellow notice bar, as I have switched the annoying information bar off.

But when I switched it ON, I saw the bar and allowed my page for popup.

Alas: clicking on the thumbnail did not give the popped up image, nothing happened.

And when I went to this newsgroup I could not popup the answer in

'full format'.

But when I deleted the updates I could popup again ...

I assume it must be some security setting which somehow conflicts with

the set of new updates.

Any ideas ??

Jan,

Just tested your site and am not seeing the behavior you've described.

All the updates are installed, IE6 SP2, on an XP Pro SP2 system.

Did you see the yellow notice bar appear informing you that a popup was blocked ?

Add :

to the allowed popup sites or reenable the Notification Bar so that you can approve the popup.

The following update SHOULD be installed ASAP as their is active exploitation of this vulnerability currently on the net –

Microsoft Security Bulletin MS06–061  
Vulnerabilities in Microsoft XML Core Services Could Allow Remote Code Execution (924191)

stand-alone local machine  
does  
not work correctly anymore,  
as some scripts are not  
executed anymore.  
Instead – after invoking the  
script error notification in IE  
-> Tools  
-> Security I see the  
message: Access is denied,  
followed by the URL.  
And also my life website  
has exactly the same  
problems for me ....

I tried several changes in the  
IE security settings but that  
did not  
help; even Custom level  
LOW did not help :-\

But Mozilla Firefox has no  
problems at all :o)

So I deleted the installation  
of the above updates and  
now it works  
again.  
No, I did not try the updates  
one by one to find out which  
one  
causes the pain, as I think  
this is up to Microsoft  
developers.

I have switched off the  
Automatic Update function  
so that I will not  
be surprised with an  
unwanted installation.  
But alas: many of my  
website visitors also run IE  
and will  
experience the same  
problem, I am afraid.
