Looks like the Express service is disabled. The service needs to be startable for the upgrade to complete. Go to Administrate Tools and then Services. Look for the entry called "SQL Server (ACT7)". Right-click on the entry and choose properties. You should see the "Startup Type" is disabled. Change the "Startup Type" to manual. Rerun the installation through Microsoft Update.
