

802.1x / EAP Validate Server Certificate

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Hello,

Do any of you wireless / 802.1x experts know how to tell the CE EAP supplicant, for example PEAP, not to validate the server certificate?

I'm using 802.1x with 802.11 (Zero Config service), and I have found the registry keys and documentation for
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE/Comm/EAP/Extension/25/InvokeUserNameDialog etc.

I have also found the keys
HKEY_CURRENT_USER/Comm/EAPOL/Config/[your_SSID]/Password , etc.

However, I can find no way to tell it not to validate the server certificate. (A very bad security practice, I know, but one some customers/consumers demand.)

(Also I'm not sure how the PEAP password is encoded, but I'm guessing regular NT hash.)

Thanks for any pointers.
