- > 0x87ecb800: FLASHDRV.DLL:CP\_StartCompactor() – There aren't any DIRTY
- > sectors left; the compactor can't be started
- > 0x87ecb800: FLASHDRV.DLL:SM\_GetNextFreeSector() – Unable to start compactor
- > in critical situation!!!
- > 0x87ecb800: FLASHDRV.DLL:SM\_GetNextFreeSector() – Unable to reclaim any free
- > sectors in a critical compaction stage. Media must be full.
- > 0x87ecb800: FLASHDRV.DLL:WriteToMedia() – Unable to get next free physical
- > sector address for writing! The media is full...
- > 0x87ecb800: FLASHDRV.DLL:WriteToMedia() failed.
