I'm having a problem with the system going into suspend.

1. When I press the power button it goes into suspend fine.
2. When I use the menu Start/Suspend it works fine
3. When I wait for the timer to go off (i.e. 5 minutes) sometimes it will go into suspend but usually it won't. I haven't been able to figure out the pattern.

Is it possible that a driver is stopping the system from suspending? If so what is the mechanism that a driver would use so that I can find the culprit and perhaps modify it?

I've set the registry settings under

Is it documented anywhere what

```
