I probably didn't articulate well enough (not knowing the proper names for icons). Your response is how it "should" work... but it isn't working. When I click on the restore icon, the borders should be resizable, but they're not. Usually the cursor will change to a double headed arrow or something similar, but it doesn't and won't allow resizing.

>With the window maximized, click on the middle icon (Restore). Then you can

>click the window borders to resize it. Once you have it like you want,

>click the "middle icon again (now says maximize). It returns to full

>screen. Click the "Restore" once more and it return to how you resized it

>earlier.
