> Is the 'icon' called ~\$filename ? It sounds as though you have the desktop  
> set as the document location or the temp file location. Windows 98 is rather  
> poor when it comes to housekeeping and often forgets to delete its temporary  
> files, when you quit applications or Windows itself. Change the Windows temp  
> file location to c:\windows\temp or c:\temp and the documents location to a  
> documents folder. Ensure that any orphaned temp files are removed from time  
> to time. It's been a long time since I used Win98, but I seem to recall that  
> you set the temp location from the auutoexec.bat file – I would check with a  
> Windows 98 newsgroup.

> You can safely temporary files when the application that creates them is  
> closed. The best time to do so is immediately after switching the PC on.
