I am also having the same problem and its driving me mad! I have tried absolutely everything to fix it! On mine, it will not print anything below about an inch from the bottom of the page. Also, any text within that inch does not show up in the print preview. My problem is within the whole of windows, meaning whatever application i try and print from. Even when i print from Internet Explorer, the line which shows the address of the page prints not at the bottom of the page, but an inch upwards.

Can anyone help me? This is driving me mad, and with 2 businesses running, it is making me insane. Please Please Please can someone help me?

>>>>> This appears to only affect documents originating from Word 2003.

>>>>> The problem I am having, as is another co-worker, is that when I print some, not all, Word documents the bottom 2.67" is getting cut off. If you look at the preview the bottom is missing but if you look at the actual document there is text. When I go to check the margins everything is fine with a 1" margin all around. When I press ok it tells me that I need to either fix or ignore the margins. If I choose "Fix" it changes the bottom margin to 2.67".

>>>>>>> The problem is not fixed if I save and close it. I know it isn't the printer. This is a shared document, and other computers can open it and print without problems. However, they are not using Word 2003.
