Something like this to run on exit from the dropdown:

```
Sub ExpandField()  
Dim oFrmFld As FormFields  
Set oFrmFld = Selection.FormFields  
Select Case oFrmFld(1).Result  
Case Is = "Bill"  
oFrmFld(1).Result = "Bill Jones, 101 Miller Street"  
Case Is = "Bob"  
oFrmFld(1).Result = "Bob Smith, 57 East Maple Ave."  
Case Else  
End Select  
End Sub
```
