PDF is intended as a non editable format. If you copy the text into Word all you achieve is a copy of the plain text content, which does not support colour attributes (in some circumstances, you would not even be able to copy the text in this manner). Your only options are to format the resulting document as you require it, or to obtain the original document from which the PDF was created and edit that.
