Hi Shawn,

The 'Routing Recipient' dialog was, if I recall correctly, removed from Word 2007. The 'Send for Review' command can be added to the Quick Access Toolbar (QAT) in Word 2007 Office Button=>Word Options=>Customize (Alt, F, I, C) then select the 'all commands' list and then Add the 'Send for Review' command to the QAT. Word's assumption to use this to attach a routing slip is that you're using Outlook 2007 along with Word 2007.
