Suzanne, thanks for the hidden text trick. I'll try that as a work-around.

Graham, you're correct. I was using TNR. When I change the font to Calibri, I don't get the same behavior.

Following is the paragraph in issue, I'm using tags to show formatting:

"for Transit, its servants, agents, contractors, subcontractors, licensees and invitees to enter upon the <bold>Transit Lands</bold><underline> for the purpose of <bold>constructing, erecting, repairing, altering, improving</bold>, maintaining, removing and reconstructing the Transit Facilities</underline>; and"

I am also viewing at 100%. Left and Right margins of .65. Left indent of ..25 and hanging indent of .25. Only the underline in the second line of text goes bold.
