I am working with a professor having a similar issue, and he has his language set to English (International). When he types a quotation mark, or a single quote, he must type it twice and then delete one of them to make the mark display. He says he needs to use that language – so the question is, if he needs this language, is there no other solution to his problem than to type twice and delete one? Thanks so much! (We are using Word 2007.)

The "United States – International" setting is the problem. You need to find some setting that doesn't include "International." I'm using Windows 2000, which has somewhat different settings, so I can't advise you more specifically, but the only place I find "United States – International" is if I check the box for "Keyboard Layout/IME" on the "Add Input Language" dialog that I get by clicking Add in the Text Services dialog, which I get to by clicking Change on the
