The color always appears on the screen, but disappears when I print it to pdf or printer, but only from certain PC's. On 1 PC it prints the color font when the links have been updated on that PC. If they are updated on any other PC, the text color is lost. I've compared the settings on Word and Excel between the PC that can print the colored text and the ones that cannot. To no avail.
