>> *Word and its quiriness. I have 30+ years of*
professional
>> *publishing under my belt and have access to most*
>> *professional page layout programs. QuarkXpress is my*
>> *choice for page layout. However, even Quark has it*
>> *drawbacks. Example, page/section numbering;*
>> *indexing/contents generation; end notes/footnotes are*
>> *features that I find very useful. Quark has next to*
>> *nothing in this department, i.e.: the word-processing*
>> *part vs. page layout part.*
>> *IMHO – The most frustrating part about Word is its*
>> *unpredictability with so many seemingly unrelated*
items.
>> *Like my current problem, I have deleted many section*
>> *breaks before, now all of a sudden this is happening.*

>> *If you read my previous posts, you will see my*
>> *bewilderment when dealing with art in a Word document.*
>> *Art jumping around has to be top "what were they*
>> *thinking" question when incorporating art into a Word*
>> *document. This has to be the top complaint I have from*
>> *users/students. I have always felt there should be an*
>> *option that says "DO NOT MOVE THIS ART."*
