I found the menu toolbar and clicked "reset". However, that didn't change anything. When I click on tables, auto fit I get the following options only: auto fit to contents, autofit to window, fixed column width, distribute rows evenly and distribute columns evenly. So far, this is the only thing I see missing in my program!
